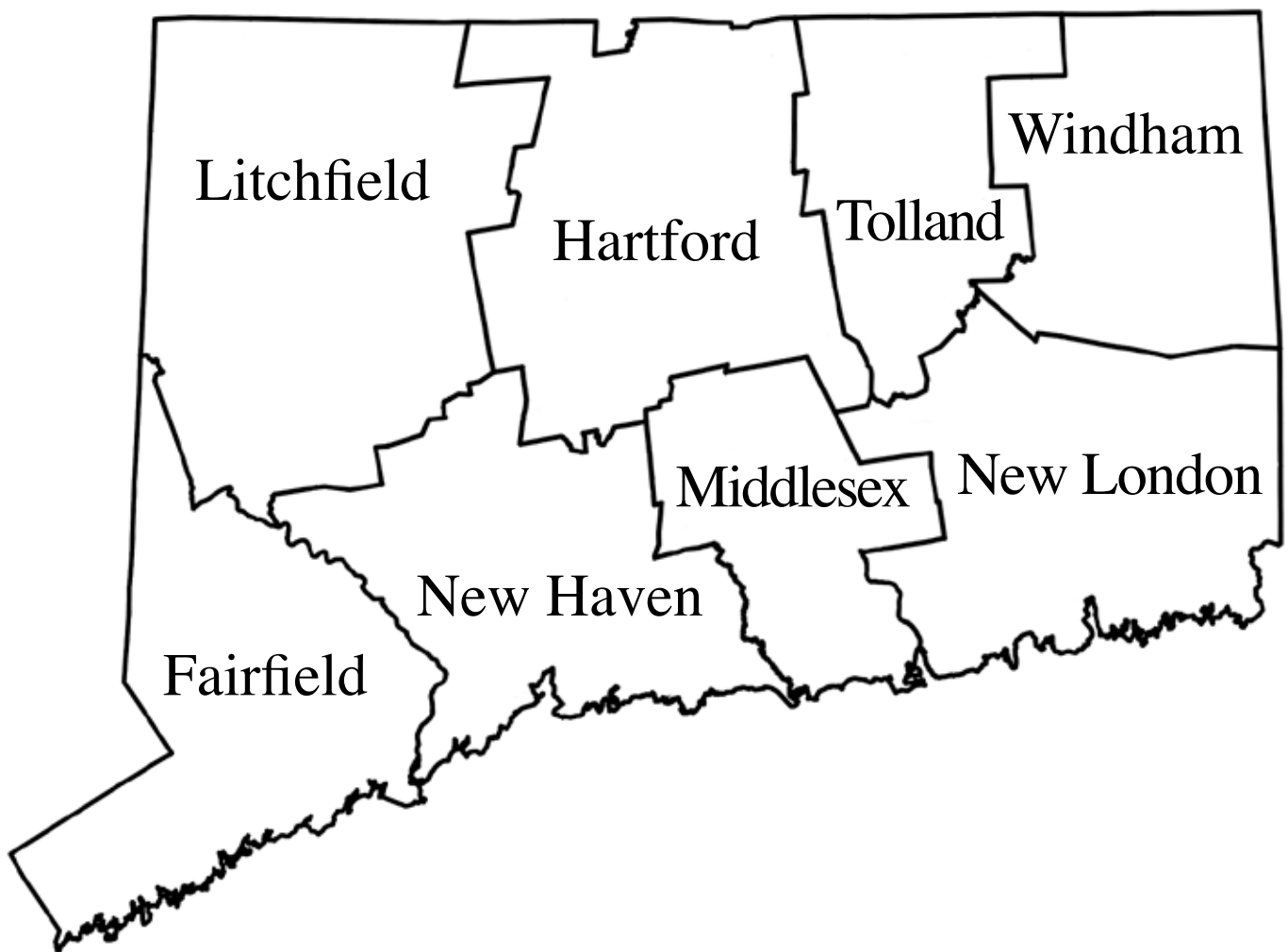

*During the eighteenth and nineteenth centuries much of the mail traveled by horse and wagon. Often a loud post horn was blasted to announce the arrival of the mail.*

*The mail stages used on the country routes were rarely as grand as the stage coaches that crowd wild west movies, but rather more humble in character. And they served a variety of transport functions. Such was the case on the Greenfield Hill to Southport and Bridgeport run.*

*The mail carrier in question was Mr. C. H. Ricker, who drove a surrey type wagon with side curtain enclosures. With stereotypical Connecticut Yankee ingenuity, Mr. Ricker equipped it with a small coal burning stove, its crooked pipe projecting through the roof. Of course, that necessitated making room for some coal to be brought along for the cold winter journey. As for a post horn, not at all. He simply tied a cowbell around his horse's neck.*
